  - Creates opportunities for community outreach and education



## Before You Trap (continued)

 Create a plan and schedule for the trapping, transport, and return of the cats.

- Determine a safe, indoor location where you will be able to hold the cats after surgery while they recover
  - Gather and prepare all of the appropriate equipment and understand how it works ahead of time. Test traps each time to ensure that the trip plate works.
- Line the back seat of the transport vehicle with a plastic tarp.
  - Have anyone who is feeding the cats withhold food for <u>at least</u> 24 hours before trapping
